Agenda of the Meeting:

Secretary General CRA, Mr. Jayesh Joshi requested the President to start the meeting with the agenda decided .President Dr. B.S. Panwar welcomed all members and initiated the meeting.

Presentation of last three Month Report

1. Mr. Sandeep first thanked to all members. He listed Many of highlights as given below:-

We are happy to share with you the activities which we have undertaken after taking over charge from the outgoing Executive Committee on February 15, 2021.

The Paid Member of CRA Increased to 150 from 144 during the period.

- 1) Submitted a project in the Ministry of I& B to organize awareness orientation workshops for new and upcoming Community Radios Stations (CRs) and Capacity Building workshops for old CRs. The selection process is in progress and we will know the outcome by next month.
- 2) Immediately after taking charge, we, met the Joint Secretary MIB and Additional Director (CR),MIB to discuss the issues and problems being faced by the CRs like nonavailability of advertisements from Bureau of Community Outreach (previously known as DAVP), problems CRs facing in getting empanelled with BOC and in getting the bills uploaded on their website, issues regarding signing of GOPA, WoL renewal of license, getting the vendors of radio equipment empanneled and other related issues. The MIB officials assured us of getting these grievances redressed in the near future.
- 3) Submitted a proposal to Chief Election Commissioner, Election Commission of India and State Election Commissioner of the five states- Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Pooduchert, West Bengal and Assam going for elections requesting them to provide financial help for organizing orientation workshops for CRs in the five states for creating awareness about participation in elections. Mr Sandeep is regularly chasing the matter with ECI and the VPs/JSs/EC members of respective states are also chasing the matter in their respective states. Our proposal is being considered favorably and we are expected to get some help from ECI.
- 4) The fresh UNICEF campaign for creating awareness about vaccination was coordinated by Mr Jayesh Joshi, Secretary General, CRA and was launched on February 22,2021 and beneifit is provided to maximum number of 60 CRs. The amount of Rs 50,000/- is being provided to each station.
- 5) Since a wide spread of COVID 19 was witnessed in Maharashtra. Special efforts were required. So, Mr Sachin, Vice President (Western Region) coordinated with UNICEF to formulate a fresh media strategy to control the spread through CRs in Maharashtra. CRA submitted another proposal about 200 CRS on COVID-19 Vacinnation to UNICEF.

- 6) We met the Director, CEMCA and requested her to organize an Orientation Workshop for "Documentation & Report Writing". CEMCA has agreed to organize the Orientation Workshop for all CRs in a batch 100 stations in each batch during the months of April, May and June, 2021. The first workshop is expected to be organized on April 15 & 16,2021.
- 7) We despatched proposals to the Ministry of Agriculture and Ministry of Health for projects to CRs.
- Dr. B.S. Panwar, Presdent CRA suggested two co-opted Members include in CRA Executive Committee. All EC Members agreed with Dr. B.S Panwar. Two Members of co-opted are mention below:

Mr. Jayesh Joshi, Secretary General CRA, Presentation of Present & Future –CRA Current & Future role & responsibility.

Current Role: -

Mr. Jayesh Joshi, Secretary General CRA said, The current role of CRA seems to be that of an association but is actually working as an organization working on its own reaching out to various departments for programmes and sources for funding. The CRA tries to get money from various ministries and then moves ahead only.

Future Role and Responsibility

Mr. Jayesh Joshi, Secretary General CRA said, The CRA actually needs to work on the following to be like an organization which it was supposed to have done but could not put into practice.

- Capacity Building for CR on:
 - a. Business Development and fund Mobilisation
 - b. Liasoning with Govt Department and others agencies
 - c. Documentation and Content Development, System Strengthening
 - d. Technical Know how
- The National level as well as State level Advocacy efforts like:
 - a. Budget allocation,
 - b. Involving as a important stockholder in mass communication
- Work for Policy Changes like Licence fee, Frequency, DAVP, opening the other stations as well as stop the business house as a CR
- Interaction event for donors CR relation building
